Lining Up

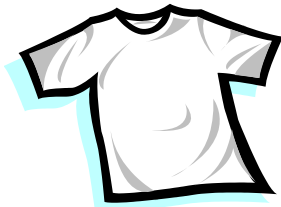
All classes line up on the astroturf in the playground. Children are expected to line up one behind the other ready to come into school. Teachers will wait until the children show they are ready before bringing them in.
